Family History Library News

The Family History Library has added two new services recently: a **Library Lookup Service** and **Virtual Genealogy Consultations**.

Family History Library Adds a Library Lookup Service

With the closure of the Family History Library in Salt Lake City a year ago due to the COVID-19 pandemic, people have had to rely largely on online materials, unable to access records that are only viewable at the Family History Library or other locations. To offset pandemic restrictions and as part of an effort to serve a global audience living too far away to visit the Library, the Family History Library has launched its own lookup service.

Upon request, staff and volunteers at the Library will look up specific records in their collections that cannot be viewed online. Since Library Lookup is not a research service, people will need to identify the specific record from FamilySearch.org that they need to see. Requests may take a few weeks to process, depending on the volume of requests being handled at a given time.

After the COVID-19 restrictions are lifted and the Library reopens, the Library Lookup Service will continue as part of the FamilySearch global outreach.


