I received an email today from Loretta with whom I have been corresponding and have talked about in previous newsletters. Today's surprise was a letter written from her aunt to her uncle mentioning my great grandmother Lillie just delivering an 8 pound baby girl named Bertha Hazel - my grandmother.

Interestingly, the letter is dated March I, 1915 and Bertha's birthdate was February 27, 1916. I told Loretta that all papers have my grandmother's birth year as 1916 so could her aunt have made a mistake with the year even three months afterwards.

I just received the answer as I was writing this message. The year should be 1916 as the much younger brother was mentioned as talking and in 1915 he would have only been a month old. Mystery solved with this one.

I just love when genealogies are shared. This two sentence mention of my grandmother and great grandmother in a letter in the possession of someone I didn't know a few months ago just made my day!




